## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS & STUDY:

- 1. List the characteristics of God mentioned in Isaiah 44:24-28.
- 2. Why did God choose Cyrus? What does the fact that Isaiah the prophet mentioned Cyrus the Great by name more than a century before he was born teach you about God? What does it teach you about the Bible?
- 3. Cyrus is called God's "chosen one" or "anointed one" (messiah) a word used of several Israelite kings & priests. The Bible contains many "types" of Christ which gives us some insight into the person of Jesus (i.e. Joseph is consider to be a type of Christ). What might we learn from Cyrus & God's use of him?
- 4. What is the significance of the word "know" in 45:4-6? Why is v. 6 so significant.
- 5. Read this article first: <a href="https://www.gotquestions.org/Isaiah-45-7.html">https://www.gotquestions.org/Isaiah-45-7.html</a> How are we to understand 45:7? Is this difficult for you to accept? Why? How do we need to balance our idea of who God should be & what the scriptures present?
- 6. How do verses 1-3 harmonize with Deuteronomy 2:20-23; Amos 9:7; and Acts 17:26? What does this teach us about God's orchestration of human history and the rise and fall of every nation/kingdom/ empire that there has ever been?
- 7. How does Isa 45:9-10 convict you? When are you tempted to argue with your Maker? How could we learn to humble ourselves and not question God so much?
- 8. Compare verse 23 with Philippians 2:10-11. What is the significance of the fact that Paul applies this verse to Jesus Christ?
