v. 4b – listens attentively	v. 1 – suffers for their own iniquity & rebellion
v. 5a – learns the will of God	v. 2a – disregards God's call
v. 5b – follows in faithful obedience	49:14; v. 2b – questions/unconvinced of God's love/care
v. 6 – obeys even at the cost of suffering	v. 2b – doubtful of God's ability & rest in self
vv. 7-9 – confident faith in the Lord; rests in him
