1. What are some of the common views of Jesus' kingdom that you are aware of? How might you answer (assuming respectfully) the different understandings?
2. Read Revelation 21:22-27 - how do these verses compare to what we read in Isaiah 60-62? What is similar/ what is different?
3. If the promises in Isaiah 60-62 relate primarily to Israel, what promises of God do you go to for encouragement in your life?
4. In Isaiah 61 / Luke 4 - (the part that relates to Jesus' ministry) - which items in the list do you identify with? Why?
5. Please read 1 Peter 2 - what things pop out to you that we have read about in Isaiah 60-62? In chapter 2 - what are the practical ramifications of being "the people of God?"
6. What changes might be necessary in your life or that of your family?
