**3. PEACE IN \_\_\_\_\_ (Isa 26:3; Phil 4:6-7; Col 3:15)**

*Trust in \_\_\_\_\_. (Isa 26:3)*

*Bring it to him in \_\_\_\_\_. (Phil 4:6-7)*

~ Command – “do not be anxious” – give us direction

~ Manner – “with thanksgiving” – gives us vision

~ Promise – “peace of God” – gives us hope

*Let peace \_\_\_\_\_ in your life (Col 3:15)*

**Seeking forgiveness when  
we've hurt others**

- Address everyone involved.
- Avoid if, but, and maybe.
- Admit specifically.
- Acknowledge the hurt.
- Accept the consequences.
- Alter your behavior.
- Ask for forgiveness.

**Forgiveness Means:**

- I will not dwell on this incident.
- I will not bring this incident up and use it against you.
- I will not talk to others about this incident.
- I will not allow this incident to stand between us or hinder our personal relationship.
