1. We have a problem – _____ (1 Jn 3:5)

2. We have an accuser – _____ (Rev 12:10)

Ever been falsely accused?

Satan’s very nature is to be an accuser (Job 1)

Be we have an intercessor! (See Isa 53:12; Rom 8:34; 1 Tim 2:5; Heb 7:24-25; 9:24; 1 Jn 2:1)

3. We have a command – _____ (Eph 2:11-13)

“Remember” (v. 11) – continual command – *keep on remembering over & over & over...*

Why? – Memory is meant to make an impression!

- We are _____ the sanctification process & need his renewing work.

 - See Phil 3:20; 2 Cor 5:20
 - What is important to remember as U.S. citizens?

4. We have a hope – _____ (Titus 2:13)

(see Jn 14:6; Eph 1:14; Heb 7:25; Phil 3:20-21; Acts 1:11)

Are we sharing this hope with people who are lost in hopelessness?
