Romans 14:1-12 How have you wrongly judged someone? Significance of Chs. 14-15: 12:1-2 – Two verses on the Christian mind 12:3-8 – Six verses on proper estimation 12:9-21 – Thirteen verses on Christian love 13:1-7 – Seven verses on the church & government 13:8-10 - Three more verses on love 13:11-14 – Four verses on living in light of Christ's return 14:1-15:7 - \*THIRTY-FIVE VERSES\* on judgement & non-essential matters in the church! \_\_\_\_\_ Is Key to Harmony (vv. 1-4) Note the COMMANDS: v. 1 - receive (accept) v. 3 – <u>do not despise</u> – v. 3 – must not judge – Note the CONTRAST: Strong -Weak -Paul doesn't give the reason for "differing opinions;" just tells us there will be. That should be our main focus rather than trying to find out why because these are the grounds often for CONFLICT & DIVISION. **EXAMPLE:**
